DESIGNATION OF ORIGIN

PORTIA is the name of the seventh satellite circling Uranus, the innovative planet par excellence, symbolising all that is rebellious and original. Astrologically, it represents the discoverer, the pioneer.

PORTIA, of Latin origin, means "offering", giving gifts and sacrifices for the supernatural beings as a sign of adoration and devotion.

So that, Portia, is the result of a double meaning. Modernity (innovation, originality) represents the avant-garde spirit of the wine that we are going to offer. On the other side tradition (offering) symbolize Don Julio's tribute to all his customers and friends, that have done possible the 140 years of history of the Faustino Group.

The Origin

Faithful to its principles, the Faustino Group began its venture in Ribera del Duero by acquiring white soils and planting them with vines in the 1990s. The Group owns 160 hectares distributed among the municipalities of Roa, Villanueva de Gumiel and Gumiel de Izán. A selection of grapes from our best vineyards has given rise to this unique wine: Portia.

Tasting Notes

GRAPE VARIETIES

Tinta Fina del País. 100% Tempranillo.

AGEING

For 10 months in new American oak casks, followed by a further 6 month's refinement in the bottle.

TASTING

Garnet cherry-red intense with aromas of blackberries and red currants.

In the mouth, an excellent balance between fruit and wood provides creamy sensations and pleasant toasty notes.

MATCHING

Roasted red meat dishes with sauces that include this wine in their preparation, seasonal pulses, rice dishes and medium-cured cheeses.
